The Grace Resolution: It's not about trying harder, it's about leaning deeper

On January 1, many of us make New Year's resolutions. It's become a trope, however, that these resolutions are more often abandoned than fulfilled. By the end of January, roughly 36% to 43% of people have already given up. Why? Because we rely on our own willpower. The apostle Paul talked about having "a thorn in [his] flesh" which tormented him constantly. It could have been physical, like an ailment or an illness; internal, like an addiction or compulsive struggle; mental, like anxiety or depression; or situational and relational, like a difficult person or situation. Whatever it was, he admitted that he was powerless to overcome it on his own. He didn't pretend he was fine, he didn't blame himself for struggling, and he didn't resolve to fight it alone. Instead, he gave it over to God.

God said, "My grace is sufficient for you [My lovingkindness and My mercy are more than enough—always available—regardless of the situation]; for My power is being perfected [and is completed and shows itself most effectively] in your weakness."

(2 Corinthians 12:9 AMP)

Paul didn't find victory by overcoming his thorn through effort and self-improvement. He found it when he realized that the end of his strength was where God's power began. Imagine if, rather than self-improvement, we made resolutions of self-surrender—drawing not on our own strength, but on God's grace.
